

New Training Requirement for Guardians (HB 3376)

What is the new law?

Texas law ([Texas Government Code 155.204](#)) now requires some guardians to take yearly training about Alzheimer's disease and dementia.

Who must take the training?

Guardians of people age 60 or older, or those with Alzheimer's, dementia, or related conditions.

When is it due?

New guardians: within 6 months of appointment and every year after. Current guardians: complete by September 1, 2026.

Are there exceptions?

Temporary guardians may not need training unless extended. Courts may waive requirement in some cases.

Who checks this?

Turn your certificate in to the court overseeing the guardianship.

How to complete the training

2. Log in or create account
3. Select Alzheimer's Training Video
4. Watch video
5. Confirm completion
6. Save or print certificate
7. Give certificate to the court

Nuevos requisitos de capacitación para los tutores (Ley HB 3376)

¿En qué consiste la nueva ley?

La legislación de Texas ([Código de Gobierno de Texas, artículo 155.204](#)) exige ahora a algunos tutores que reciban capacitación anual sobre la enfermedad de Alzheimer y la demencia.

¿Quién debe recibir la capacitación?

Los tutores de personas de 60 años o más, o de aquellas que padezcan Alzheimer, demencia o enfermedades relacionadas.

¿Cuándo hay que hacer la capacitación?

Nuevos tutores: en un plazo de 6 meses desde su nombramiento y cada año a partir de entonces. Tutores actuales: deben completarla antes del 1 de septiembre de 2026.

¿Hay excepciones?

Es posible que los tutores provisionales no necesiten recibir la capacitación, a menos que se prorrogue su mandato. Los tribunales podrán eximirlos del requisito en algunos casos.

¿Quién lo verifica?

Entregue su constancia al tribunal que supervisa la tutela.

Cómo cumplir con la capacitación

1. Acceda a guardianship-txcourts.talentlms.com
2. Inicie sesión o cree una cuenta
3. Seleccione el vídeo de capacitación sobre el Alzheimer
4. Vea el vídeo
5. Confirme que ha terminado con la capacitación
6. Guarde o imprima la Constancia de cumplimiento
7. Entregue la constancia al tribunal

The 89th Texas Legislature passed [HB 3376](#), which amends [Texas Government Code 155.204](#) to require certain guardians to complete an annual training regarding Alzheimer's Disease, Dementia, and related disorders. The Supreme Court of Texas adopted rules regarding this in [JBCC Rule 10.3](#).

WHO DOES THIS AFFECT?

A Guardian of the person or estate or both of a ward who is 60 years of age or older, or under 60 and diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease, dementia, or a related disorder must complete a 1-hour training course on these issues within 6 months after appointment and every year thereafter. (Tex. Gov't Code 155.204(a)(2)).

WHAT ABOUT EXISTING GUARDIANS?

A guardian appointed before July 1, 2026 must complete this training by September 1, 2026.

ARE THERE EXEMPTIONS?

This does not apply to temporary guardians under Estates Code 1251 unless their term is extended.

A court may waive the training requirement under the circumstances permissible under [JBCC Rule 10.4](#).

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING TRAINING IS DONE?

The court supervising the guardianship is responsible for ensuring that guardians complete the training in a timely manner. (JBCC Rule 10.3)

HOW TO COMPLY?

- The Guardian should go to the JBCC Learning Management System at <https://guardianship-txcourts.talentlms.com>. If they have used that system before, they should use existing log-in to access this class. If not, please follow the instructions on the site to create an account.
- Select and view the Alzheimer's/Dementia Training Video (it is available in English and Spanish).
- Click certification that you have completed the Video
- Print or save certificate
- Provide the certificate to the Court supervising the guardianship.
